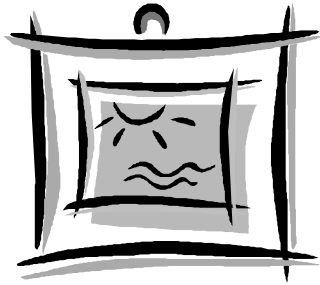

ABOUT CLASSES

The first class will consist of a demonstration showing how to begin an oil painting. This will include a discussion on elements that make a painting more pleasing to the eye (composition), the mixing of colors, and basic technique. No supplies will be needed for this first session. Those that already have supplies can bring them and get started. Those that do not have supplies will be given a list of what is needed to get started.

The art students will bring in a picture or subject that they would like to paint. As the painting begins and develops, helpful suggestions will be made on how to improve the painting. This will be for the benefit of all present. The idea is to have a number of lessons per session by listening to the instructor help each student.



SCHEDULE

Classes start in April

Oil painting classes will be held on Tuesday afternoons from **1:00 to 4:00 P.M.** Other days are available.

The classes will last for four weeks. The fee for the 4 week class will be **\$40.00**

The following supplies will be needed:

1. Set of basic oil colors (ultramarine blue, viridian green, yellow ochre, burnt sienna, white, and alizarin crimson).
2. Two small glass jars with lids for mineral spirits (to clean brushes) and linseed oil (to mix with the oil pigments).
3. The mineral spirits and linseed oil will be supplied.
4. A set of brushes
5. Stretched canvas or canvas board. Not to be over 18"x24" for beginners
