## ABOUT CLASSES

### For Guitar:

Zach teaches specifically to the needs/preferences of the student - For instance,

A student who wants to learn speed metal, or blue grass.

Will teach basic music theory and how to read music



### For Voice:

For beginners, we start with the basics. First learning the basics of voice control, including learning to adjust your voice to different pitches (i.e. singing on key). All along we will strengthen the voice and stretch out the range .

Once we have a good foundation and the student can hear a note, sing it back, then hear several notes and sing them back with the proper technique, (which will not damage the voice). We will then start on application, getting the student singing an entire song.
